When we began our journey as missionaries one year ago, we thought we had to hurry up and raise our financial support so that we could report to the ministry headquarters to "do ministry"; however, we have learned that as soon as you say "Yes" to the Lord, He uses you immediately. It has been humbling to see how much God has used us to do ministry. Here are just a few of the things that the Lord has enabled us to do over the last 12 months.

- We have gone on over 200 ministry appointments, sharing about FamilyLife, and encouraging everyone to strengthen their relationship with the Lord and their family.
- We have shared the Gospel message on 2 appointments and 1 person prayed to receive Christ!
- We have met with people from 20 different churches in the area.
- We have met with leadership/missions teams from 3 different churches. They all have plans to use FamilyLife resources in their church.
- We have helped 14 couples attend a Weekend to Remember in the past 6 months. There are 3 couples who have already signed up to attend the Weekend to Remember in St. Louis this November.
- We recruited 1 couple from our church to host The Art of Marriage and the 6 couples that attended came back with EXCELLENT reviews.
- We led 2 individuals to sign up to become eMentors.
- We have taught many couples how to pray out-loud for each other.
- We connected 2 ministry partners to use the FamilyLife Passport2Purity material with their teenage children.
- On 11 appointments people opened up and shared about serious issues they were experiencing within their own marriage or family and we were able to direct them to FamilyLife for help and hope.
- Almost 50% of our monthly financial support has been raised!
