Without the Technology Team, there is no way our ministry could be reaching around the globe.

Just last week one of the mentors on my team (who lives in Australia) connected with a Muslim woman

from Africa. Check out the conversation that has unfolded so far: (Below are snippets of several email messages)

Muslim woman from Africa asks for help "Lately I feel alone and depressed I need someone to take care of me and help go through this, I really need someone please help me thank you."

> eMentor prays for her "I pray for my friend who is lonely and brokenhearted. Jesus, you said that you came to heal the brokenhearted. I pray that you will reveal yourself to her and show her how much you love her and want to comfort her in her loneliness."

Woman from Africa "I am a Muslim girl... I read the Koran, but I don't have any problems in knowing other religion or reading the bible. Right now I really feel alone. I don't want to be pessimistic I wanna be happy because I used to be happy and always laugh but I had a lot of problems lately. All I need is to get away I can't live here anymore."
