A text message from a stranger - An opportunity to share about Jesus

Late one evening as I (Jennifer) was getting ready for bed, I received a text message that was clearly not for me. Within the message there were clues that this was from a distressed man who was expressing fears that his relationship was falling apart. I almost ignored the message and went to bed but Nathan encouraged me to text back. I texted that he had the wrong number but that I am involved in a marriage ministry and asked if I could help. I expected to not hear from him again; however, a few minutes later, he responded. After several back and forth messages, Chris* asked if he and his girlfriend, Laura*, could call me so I set up a time to have a conference call with them.



I ended up talking with this couple for 1-1/2 hours and my eMentoring training really came in handy. I first just listened as they each told their stories. I learned that they had been living together for a couple of years, and how they recently found that they are expecting a baby. They were struggling as a couple to "make it" and there was a lot going wrong for each of them.

When they finished telling their stories, I asked a simple question, "What do you want in the future, what would be the best-case scenario for your future?" Finally they shared something that they both could agree on! They want to be together and they want to raise their baby together. *That was enough of an opening to share about Jesus!*

I shared that their goal of getting married and being a family was entirely possible! However, they would need help, and that help can only be found through Jesus Christ! I shared with them how my personal relationship with Jesus has changed my life and my marriage. They both opened up and shared how each of them had made a decision to follow Jesus early in their life, but how they had walked away from Him in their adult life.

I encouraged them to get into a Bible-teaching church, surround themselves with godly people, and to start focusing on developing a personal relationship with Jesus. As we closed our conversation, I offered to pray for them. When I finished praying, all of us were in tears. Chris and Laura thanked me and said that they had never had anyone pray for them like that before.

To God be the Glory for this Devine Interruption!

What I did was simple. I listened, I asked a few questions, I pointed them to Jesus, I encouraged them, and I prayed. All very simple things that anyone can do. We want to encourage you to listen to the Lord and be available for whenever and however he wants to use you to reach others for Christ.


