We had the pleasure of meeting an amazing couple last year, Gene and Andrea, after they attended the Art of Marriage® event we hosted at our church. They have a remarkable story that we believe will encourage and inspire you so we asked Andrea to share it:

My name is Andrea, I am a mother of 4, and have been married to Gene for 5 years. We are very blessed, but our lives weren't always this good. Gene and I dated for the first time 18 years ago. We went our separate ways after a short relationship. During that time he developed a drug problem which eventually sent him to prison and that prison time led to his sobriety.

I was in an abusive relationship for 11 1/2 years. I felt like there was no escape. Gene and I found each other again 12 years after our initial parting. He came alongside me as a friend and gave me the strength that I needed to get away from a horrible situation. We wound up getting married and as we began our marriage we went through a lot of trials. His drinking, partying and lack of communication; coupled with my inability to voice hurts and enabling him to do these things, led to disaster.



We finally decided to get in church. Shortly after attending Midtowne Church we both committed our lives to Christ! We were excited to be on this new journey with Jesus, but it wasn't until the Art of Marriage that we really connected as a couple. We learned how to communicate and we realized that it was okay to have a difference of opinion.

The Art of Marriage also led us to Nathan and Jennifer who we now consider as friends as well as our mentors. We started going to weekly bible studies at their home. We believe that God sent them to us to help our relationship grow and learn how to put His Word into practice in our marriage. As each week passed we saw more improvement in our relationship. We found a great respect for each other and in our differences. We found ourselves really listening, laughing, and talking about things without all of the frustration.

The Art of Marriage along with Nathan and Jennifer, and of course God, have been instrumental in building our marriage while showing us that by putting our marriage in God's hands and following His path for us, we can have the type of marriage that God intended us to have. There are still struggles but we work together to overcome them. We fall in love with each other over and over again as each day passes. Together, our faith will see us through!
