You are not a stepfamily, how can you lead a stepfamily class?


First off, we did not lead or teach the class...we operated more like facilitators. Thankfully, Ron Deal, a Stepfamily expert, does much of the teaching via video. Secondly, we care about marriages, all marriages! We have seen the unique challenges stepfamilies face and we wanted to do something to encourage and help them build a strong, godly, smart stepfamily. One wife said to us,

"Thank you for caring about my family. Even though you are not a stepfamily, thank you for caring about mine and hosting this class."

Do stepfamilies really need their own class?

After the first class, a wife said to us,

"Thank you for doing this. I am so glad to have a group where I feel like I belong, where I feel like people understand our family."



On conclusion of our study, we asked our participants, "What impact have you seen?"

"I have really started to see my husband's ex-wife as a family member not the enemy."

"This class has helped greatly, just the peace we now have, all our family relationships are improving. We are seeing progress."

"I think the best part of this class is knowing we are not an island. We are not alone in the struggles we face. Knowing that we are not the only ones that deal with parenting struggles, life issues, ex-spouse problems. It is good to have people to talk with, people that understand, people we can get feedback from, people that can encourage us. It is so helpful."
